



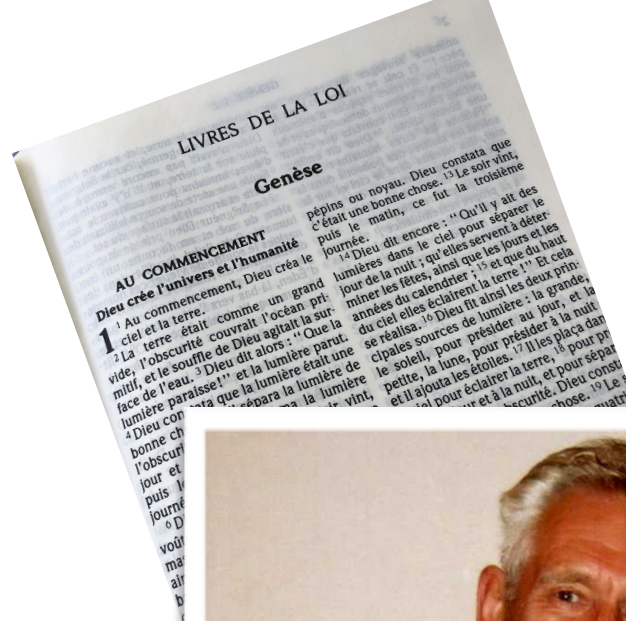
Words of Appreciation
